<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ash, sweepings - sanitary products - disposable diapers - shoes, rags - old wallpaper - broken ceramics / glass / chinaware - products made of rubber / foam / plastics - plastic items without Green Dot - cement bags <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - hot ashes - recyclable or reusable materials of any kind - hazardous materials - demolition rubble, metals, vehicle components - electrical appliances 	<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - salad / vegetable / fruit waste - coffee grounds / tea leaves - egg shells / nutshells - windfalls - lawn cuttings / tree cuttings / shrub cuttings - flowers / potting soil - foliage - plant remains - newsprint (no magazines) <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - household refuse - hazardous materials - recyclable or reusable materials - packed foodstuff - small pet bedding - plastic bags 	<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - newspapers - magazines - brochures - catalogs - books, booklets - writing paper - shredded paper - crumpled paper - cardboard - cardboard packaging with Green Dot <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sanitary paper - contaminated paper of any kind - photographic paper - cement bags - wallpaper remains - coated cardboard 	<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - furniture of any kind - mattresses - carpets or rugs - fitted carpeting - lamps - baby strollers - garden furniture made of plastic materials - rain barrels made of plastic materials <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - waste from building activities / replacement projects (such as bricks, doors or similar) - electrical appliances - vehicle components - scrap - hazardous materials - recyclable or reusable materials - garden refuse 	<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - washing machines - dishwashers - refrigerators - cooking fields / baking ovens - TV sets - computers and accessories - DVD players - coffee makers - drilling machines - electric kettles - cell phones <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - industrial appliances - recyclable or reusable materials, difficult wastes and refuse of any kind - car stereos - infectious products - fixed or stationary installations 	<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - from building activities / replacement projects, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • scrap steel • steal girders • radiator components • lead, cables or similar - from households, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • pots and pans • tubs • car rims • bicycles (excluding tires) <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - electrical appliances of any kind - bulky refuse <p>Caution!</p> <p>The edge length of the scrap Metal parts may not cross 1 m.</p>	<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - pharmaceutical product residues - paints or varnishes - primers - glues - household chemicals such as softening agents or stain removers - photographic chemicals - aerosol cans (with danger symbol) - fire extinguishers <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - car starter batteries - gas cylinders - asbestos - recyclable or reusable materials - explosives of any kind - infectious refuse 	<p>Yes!</p> <p>Packaging with Green Dot such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - plastic materials, such as mugs, laundry detergent bottles - compounds such as milk or juice cartons (beverage cartons), coated paperboard (of frozen food) - metals such as cans, aluminum trays, screw caps <p>Not!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - glasses / bottles - household refuse - hazardous materials - deposit articles - plastic items without Green Dot 	<p>Yes!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - disposable beverage bottles - foodstuff glasses - hollow glass such as ketchup glasses - pharmaceutical vials (no residues) <p>No!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - car / window glass - chinaware - drinking glasses, tumblers - filament bulbs - armored glass - mirrors <p>Caution!</p> <p>Blue glass goes into the green glass container.</p>
